Electronic Renewal Requests

What they are


- w Electronic requests from pharmacies
- w Complete orders, needing only a quick and easy authorization

What they do for you

- w No phones, no faxes = less paperwork
- w Automatically builds the active medication list
- w Decreases workload on support staff without changing provider's workload

Maximizing their use

- w Write at least 5 prescriptions electronically
- w Report faxed renewal requests to GRIPA
- w Clear out renewal requests daily



Favorites and Stickies





What they are

- w Favorites
 - Actively created by the provider
 - An alternative to drug selection on the main screen
- w Stickies
 - Passively created by the provider
 - Remembered from previous drug orders
 - Available at drug edit screen



Workflow Enhancements



Changes for the patient

- w Call the pharmacy when a renewal is needed



Changes for staff

- w Prepare prescriptions for provider authorization
- w Record allergy and pharmacy information
